

Outline - An LN-4 Community Service Project

Cost – nearly none

- **LN-4 Foundation** is able to provide 50-100 LN-4 prosthetics at no cost, with pre-registration
- Variable cost of promotion of the events – your choice and your program design
- Minor costs for some refreshments...optional

Benefits

- Those who have lost the ability to write or the ability to do tasks that require both hands will benefit immediately; recipients will regain some dignity immediately
- **LN-4 Foundation** has minor, limited application and paperwork requirements
- Any energetic Rotary Club can get involved and fairly quickly complete their first project
- There are roles for project organizers, advertising skills, and trainers who want to work directly with recipients. Rotarians and Rotaractors can do all of these tasks; other volunteers may also be involved.

- Establish an enthusiastic level of interest and engage the leaders in the Rotary Club.

Steps to Completion

- Review all the materials, requirements and responsibilities – www.LN-4.org and from emails
- You make request an LN-4 Scouting team to visit and explain project details in more detail.
- Make communications contact with the **LN-4 foundation** – discuss dates and shipping requirements
- Select a date and a location: for 1)pre-qualification work and 2)the fitting event
- Publicize both events in all media needed in all areas near to those who may benefit
- Deliver the list of pre-qualified LN-4 recipients to the LN-4 Foundation
- Receive the shipment of LN-4 prosthetics in advance of the fitting date
- Set up the location and prepare materials as needed
- Fitting Event: evaluate, register, fit and train: day of work, emotion, fun and photos.
- Send registrations and photos to **LN-4 Foundation**
- Repeat
