Statement of Program Service Accomplishments**

By the end of 2009, over 3,000 hands have been distributed in 38 countries. Approximately 1,900 individuals have been fitted with an LN-4 Hand. Each recipient has been trained in the use of the hand with life-changing stories and testimonials continuing to come in on a regular basis. On site providers (prosthetists, volunteers and members of Rotary Clubs) continue to be the primary source of locating recipients and establishing a lasting presence and distribution location for many of the recipients. The new, larger hand, called the LN-4L has all designs completed and bidding for tooling is underway with the expectation of being able to roll out this new product by the end of the year. Additionally, the foundation remains in the process of providing products for recipients with shorter below elbow residual limbs and even those with above elbow residual limbs. An overall estimate of need has been determined based on extrapolating from U S and world wide data which suggests approximately 100,000 individuals world wide are candidates for the initial LN-4 Hand.
