"This project is very illuminating", said William, as he learned and observed and participated, and we all agree. William is holding a photo of the 3 people who assembled the hand we gave to him. Chau Yoder (D5160) is fitting the hand and instructing William in essential details. It was an honor and a pleasure to work with William for the duration of our work in Arequipa.
